Below is a list of materials that I would recommend for the class. If you have favorite materials at home that you're comfortable using please feel free to bring them along. I'll have extras of everything so no worries if you're not able to obtain all the items.

- Watercolor Tubes - For student brands I recommend Grumbacher Academy, or Winsor Newton Cotman. For Artist brands I recommend Winsor Newton Artist Series or Daniel Smith. Below are a few basic colors but please bring all your regular paints and brushes.

Alizarin Crimson
Permanent Rose
Opera pink
Lemon Yellow
Cadmium Yellow
Ultramarine Blue
Indanthrone Blue

- Brushes - short handle pointed round watercolor brushes, sable or synthetic - Size 2,4,6
- Palette - Plastic or ceramic 8-12 well
- HB Drawing Pencil and Sharpener
- Kneaded Eraser
- Paper - 2-3 sheets 11x14 Hot Press or Cold Press Watercolor Paper - 140# - I would recommend Fabriano or Arches
- Water Container - glass jar is preferable
- A board to tape down your painting - We'll be using wet washes so the paper will buckle unless you have it taped down all the way around.
- 1" wide artist tape or blue painters tape will do
